WHAT WE DO



Foster Arizona Housing Project, in partnership with Keys to Success, launched in March 2018 to provide aged-out youth from foster care transitional housing, mentors, opportunities for growth and learning, and ongoing support.

Foster Arizona's Kid Connection Events focus on kids within the Arizona foster care system. These events provide a real-life point of connection between kids and the members of the community interested in supporting them, through meeting a practical need they have or allowing them to "just be kids" for a day.



Through our work with multi-media, we are focusing our efforts on education through telling stories as well as resource videos. **Real Stories** videos break down barriers and help encourage others to get involved and make a difference.

Connections and support in the foster care system are a critical component to success. **Foster Cooperative** is a digital community distribution platform for champions of at-risk children to find connections, peer-to-peer supports, quality resources and training, community events, and innovative communication methods in order to empower those caring for kids with tools needed to succeed.


Dear Applicant:
